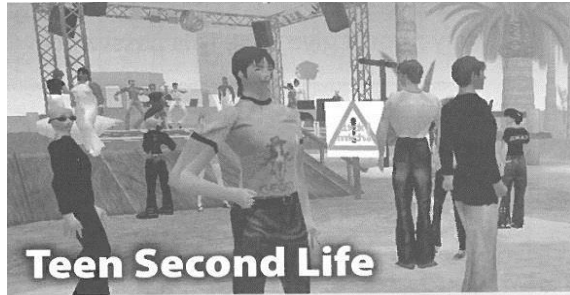

In fact, Jan spends at least three hours a day playing a game online. What's his secret? Why is Jan so brilliant at English? His secret is TSL – Teen Second Life.

TSL is a virtual world for thirteen to seventeen-year-olds and it's free to join. In TSL, teenagers from around the world have their own avatar. 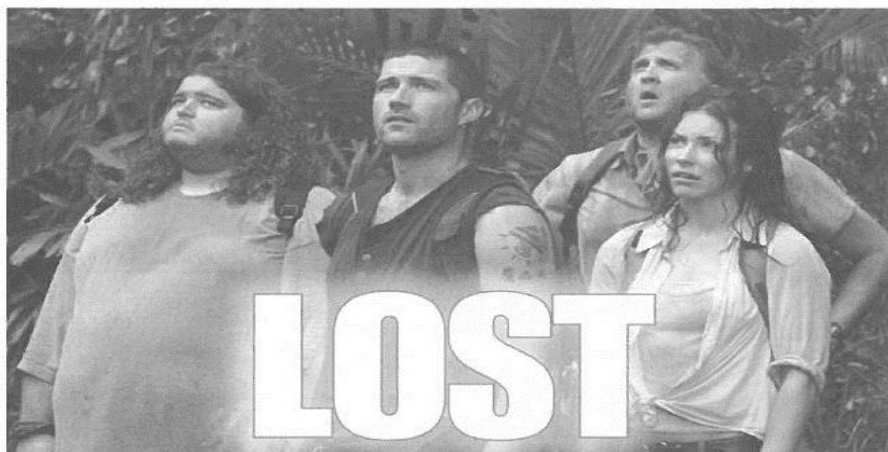

The flashbacks explained a lot about the characters, but the island kept its secrets.

Audiences loved *Lost* because the plot was very unusual. The island was still a mystery when the series ended, after 114 episodes, in 2010.
